

Year 2017 congress will be held in Bologna Italy 29th to 31st of May as an international congress together with an annual national congress of the Association of Italian Hospital Engineering (SIAIS).

The IFHE-Europe is now the biggest event of its kind in the European region and can be seen as the most important platform for the discussion of hospital-specific technical topics.

The Objectives of IFHE Europe:

- to gain an overall view of the challenges facing European healthcare policy in general and the associated technology- and organization - specific topics in particular, whilst taking into account the particular circumstances in each country.
- Improvement of technical and infrastructural management in hospitals
- Promoting awareness for efficient hospital engineering
- Discussion on comparative experiences and working methods
- Promotion of multi-disciplinary integrated planning and design
- Improvement of efficiency in the management of technical processes, maintenance and safety in hospitals

The topics under discussion constitute a cross-section of the most important technical and infrastructural problem issues that hospitals face: energy saving and energy efficiency improvement, planning and design optimization, architecture and landscape, maintenance and safety in hospital sharing experiences, ICT improvement and innovation, European regulations and responsibilities, sustainable development, hospital hygiene, Health Technology Assessment amongst others.

The conference focuses on comparing information on best practice and exchanging experiences in order to encourage innovation, benchmarking and the creation of common European standards.

The target audience of the IFHE-Europe encompasses executives in the healthcare industry, management, development, heads of medical technology departments, construction, safety, IT, energy, building services engineering and hygiene from companies, hospitals, universities and institutes.

Approximately 500 international and national delegates are expected in Bologna to attend the conference. The congress will feature national and International companies who provide services to hospital.

DISCOVERING BOLOGNA:

The "Discovering Bologna" tour allow to discover the most important sights and monuments of the medieval city of Bologna in just a few hours. This includes:

The Re Enzo Palace, the D'Accursio Palace, Piazza Maggiore - the heart of the city - which is surrounded by the city hall, the Podestà Palace, the Palazzo dei Banchi and the Basilica of Saint Petronius.

You can also visit the Archiginnasio with a wonderful anatomical theatre made entirely of wood, the site of Santo Stefano Church, the Two Towers, the symbol of Bologna in Italy and other historical monuments of the city.



Tuesday, May 30

THE BASILICA OF SAN LUCA:

This church is just outside Bologna, exactly 4km from the city centre, linked to the city with a long portico of 666 arcades.

It was built on a hill named Della Guardia to house inside, the holy image of the "Virgin with the baby" painted, according to medieval legend, by the evangelist Saint Luke.

Pilgrims and local's tradition is to walk the top, of which the last 1.2 km, the hilly part, of this portico start from the wonderful Arco del Meloncello: offering a unique view of the skyline of Bologna.



BOLOGNA THE CONGRESS CITY



Bologna is called "The Learned City". This refers to its supremacy in having the oldest University in Europe. It was founded at the end of the 11th century. The history of the University can be discovered with these fascinating itineraries, visiting: the Archiginnasio Palazzo, the Anatomical Theatre, the University Collections, and the Medieval Museum.



Bologna also excels with another unique feature: it is the city with the most porticoes in the world. In all, it has 40 kilometres of arcades that create a very special atmosphere. The city's landscape is also made up of a large number of medieval towers. The most impressive ones are the famous Two Towers: real Medieval sky-scrapers! Climbing to the top of the Asinelli Tower, with its breath-taking view, is an incredible experience.



The different historical periods can be explored in the city and its many museums. The origins of the city are revealed by Etruscan and Roman finds preserved in the Civic Archeological Museum and in the archeological excavations of the Sala Borsa building.

Splendid examples of the art of the Middle Ages and the Renaissance can be seen in museums, churches and palazzi. Sumptuous architecture and spectacular frescoes document the vital role of Baroque in this city. All the civic museums of Bologna are free.




In Bologna area, world famous gems of the motor and sports car industry are manufactured, such as Ducati and Lamborghini.

One of the most appreciated features of Bologna: its cuisine. As a matter of fact, Bologna is also known as "The Fat City". In the heart of the city, by the main square, you can find the old market with fruit and vegetable stands, bakeries, delicatessens, fishmongers and pasta shops where tagliatelle and tortellini are made. You can try this pasta in traditional restaurants and trattorias.
